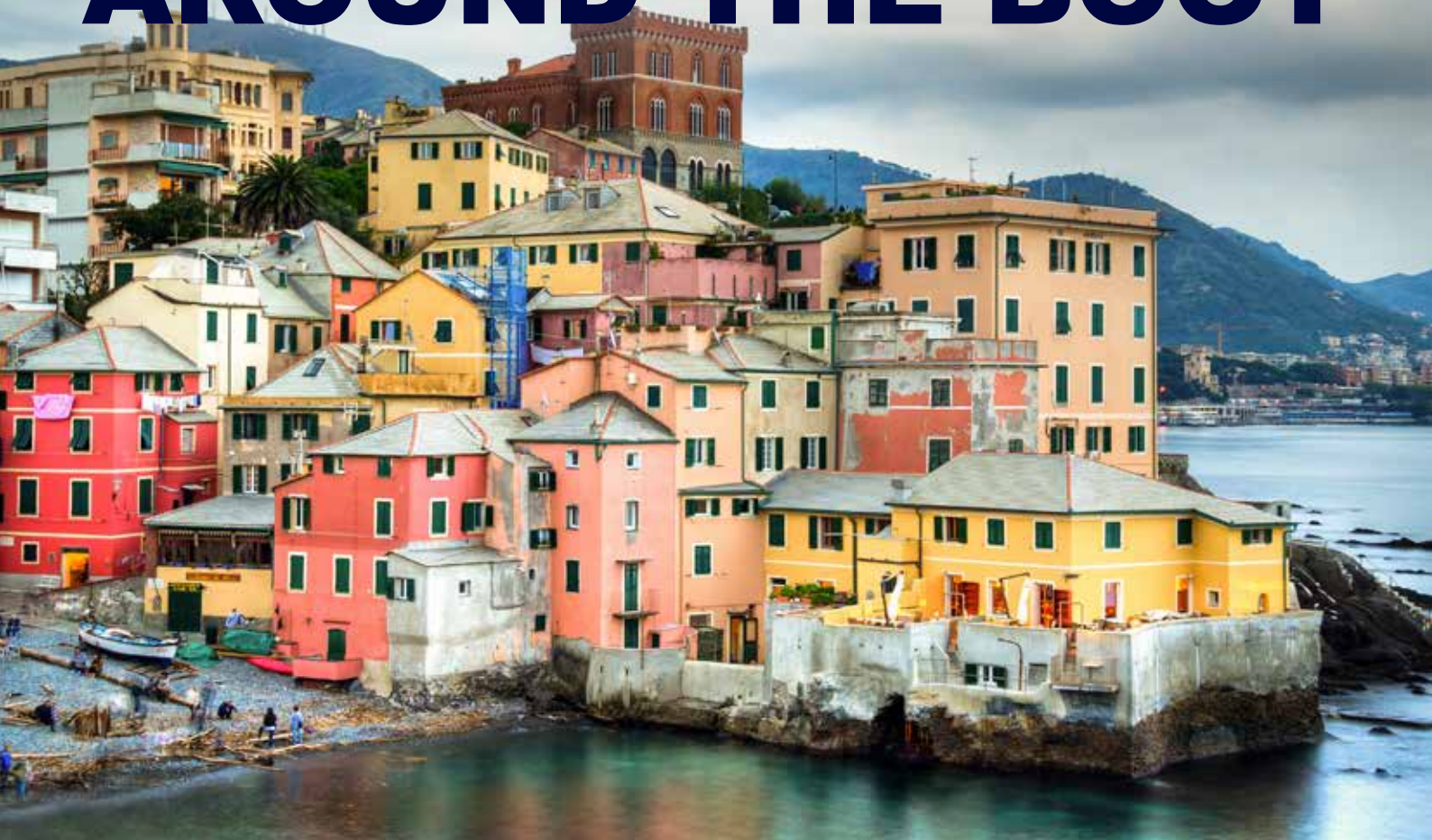

CRUISE EXCURSION HIGHLIGHTS:

KOTOR, MONTENEGRO

Kotor, whose beautifully preserved medieval centre has earned it UNESCO World Heritage Site status. A guided stroll through the maze of narrow streets and pretty squares will reveal many medieval gems, including the 12th-century Cathedral of St. Tryphon.

SPLIT, CROATIA

Explore the ancient cities of Solin and Trogir. Solin reached the pinnacle of prosperity in the 3rd & 4th-centuries. Visit to the city's archaeological excavations before driving along the Split Riviera to Trogir; founded in the 3rd-century B.C. Take in the stunning monuments of Trogir; which include the Cathedral of St. Lawrence - dating back to the 8th-century.

SANTORINI, GREECE

Sail through the "Caldera", to the tiny, uninhabited island of Nea Kameni, home to a volcano. More islands are in store as you continue to Palea Kameni where you can swim in the warm, sulphuric waters.

CEFALONIA, GREECE

Tour to one of the most stunning cave complexes in the world. Admire the numerous stalactites and stalagmites, on your walk to the stunning cavern known as the "Apotheosis Chamber" due to its excellent acoustics. Next you'll visit Agia Efimia, a small fishing village of waterside cafés and harbour taverns. Agia Efimia also boasts several beaches and St. George's Castle which you will visit.
